FITTING GUIDE

- 1. Remove and disconnect the original head unit.
- 2. Connect the 14 way molex connector to the interface



3. Connect the male power/speaker ISO harness to the female power/speaker ISO harness from the aftermarket head unit. For aftermarket head units without an ISO connector, please refer to "Wiring Colour Codes" on Pg. 2.





- 4. Connect the red/white RCA connectors from the interface to the back of the aftermarket stereo
- 5. Connect the female vehicle specific connectors on the harness to the male vehicle connector from the vehicle.
- 6. Remove the car display connector from the vehicle and plug into the interface (please remove the dust cover from the interface before making the connection).
- 7. Connect the display connector from the loom to the vehicle (the port previously occupied by the car display connector, removed in Step 7.)

Test head unit for correct operation
